

## Codes of Conduct Gymnast



- Please arrive 5 mins before the session begins
- Suitable clothing / dress code to be worn. Boys shorts & tee shirts, girls, Leotard, leggings
- Hair tied up & NO jewellery
- Respect opponents & fellow club members
- Listen to the coaches & follow instructions
- Maintain good level of behaviour at all times
- You must not use inappropriate language towards coaches, parents or other gymnasts
- Look after club equipment and not climb on until instructed to by coach
- Club does not accept any form of bullying either verbally or via social media sites
- No one -to-one communication with your coach (inc. text & emails)

## Code of conduct Parents / Carers



- Always drop off & collect your child promptly
- Encourage your child to learn the club rules & participate within them
- Ensure your child is appropriately dressed for the activity
- Establish & maintain good communications with the club & its coaches
- Support your child's involvement, help recognise good performances, not just results
- Set a good example
- No Photography, this is only to be done with prior written agreement
- Any concerns you may have, through the approved channels, first with the head coach, then if necessary follow the complaints procedures

## Code of conduct Coaches / Volunteers



- Consider the wellbeing & safety of the participants before development of performance
- build & develop an appropriate working relationship – based on mutual trust & respect
- Ensure you hold there appropriate valid qualifications
- Promote positive aspects of the sport (e.g fair play)
- Make sure activities are age / ability appropriate
- Display high standards of behaviour & appearance – be suitably dressed with positive language at all times
- Always report any incidents or disclosures immediately and follow the appropriate guidelines set out by BG safeguarding & protecting children policy.
